

## Presenter Guidelines for Accepted Abstracts

### Posters

Dear Presenter,

Congratulations on the acceptance of your abstract for presentation at the World Congress on Public Health.

To ensure a smooth and well-organized programme, please carefully review the following guidelines regarding your presentation, file submission, poster format, and registration requirements.

All presentations must be delivered **in person**. Virtual presentations will not be possible.

Please ensure that the co-authors and presenters are correctly listed on the platform. You will be able to modify on the abstract platform them until April 17<sup>th</sup>.

Please note that if there are any changes to the presenter from the original submission, the same individual may present a maximum of three contributions in total, including both poster and oral presentations.

### Registration Requirement

The presenting author (i.e., the main author indicated as presenter in the submitted abstract/application) must register for the congress.

- Registration deadline: **30th April 2026**
- Presenters who do not register by this deadline will not have their abstract included in the final programme.

Please ensure that the main author is registered and present to deliver the presentation.

Poster presentations will be displayed digitally during the congress and will be presented as part of a scientific session in a dedicated time slot that will be communicated at a later stage.

### Poster format requirements

- Format of the presentation: PDF, 62,3 x 110,6 cm (width x height, in PORTRAIT orientation).
- Upload your presentation through the online [COGRESS PLATFORM](#).

**Only the presenting author (not the submitting author) will be permitted to upload the ePoster.**

### Recommended poster structure

- Title
- Authors and affiliations
- Background / Objectives
- Methods
- Results
- Conclusions
- References / Acknowledgment

### Presentation instructions :

- Total time allocated: Live 3-minute presentation.
- Q&A: At the end of the session.

Please ensure that your presentation does not exceed the 3-minute limit, in order to allow the session to run smoothly and to give all presenters equal time.

Please note that in the event of any changes from the original submission, the same individual may present a maximum of three contributions in total, including both poster and oral presentations.
